ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

COYOTE POINT RIFLE & PISTOL CLUB, INC.

A California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation

ONE:	The name of the Corporation is: COYOTE POINT RIFLE &
PISTOL CLUB,	INC.

TWO: (A) This corporation is a nonprofit PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.

(B) The specific purpose of this corporation is to foster and advance public safety relating to firearms use, ownership and storage by providing instruction and training for the public by sponsoring basic & advanced classes on firearm use and safety; and by operating for the San Mateo County Sheriff on a volunteer bases, the County's shooting range at times it is open to the public.

THREE: The name and address in this State of the initial agent for service of process, in accordance with Corporations Code Section 6210 (b), is Donald Del Grande, 1601 Coyote Point Drive, San Mateo, CA 94401. The initial agent's mailing address is PO Box 1016. Millbrae, CA 94030-5016

FOURTH: (A) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the Meaning of Section 501 (c) (3), Internal Revenue Code.

(B) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

FIFTH The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3), Internal Revenue Code.
